Paradise awaits! Looking to really get-a-way and live like a celeb in the Naples/Marco Island area? Casa de Sol Y Vida (House of Sun and Life) is a secluded estate property located on Keewaydin Island, a private barrier island accessible only by boat – no bridges connect to the mainland.

Known as Florida's *Last Paradise*, Collier is the largest county in the state, by land area, yet more than 80% of its vast expanse is preserved. This island home is tucked between the Gulf of Mexico and the Intercoastal Waterway. One hundred sixty acres of environmentally sensitive nature estuaries, within the Rookery Bay Reserve, protect the surrounding area from development.

Located at the island's southern end, this residence is an elevated home consisting of 5 bedrooms, including a second floor private master suite with endless water views. Besides having the beach all to yourself, you can also enjoy relaxing on the wrap-around deck offering stunning 360-degree panoramic water and island views.
