TOGETHER WE CAN

The Light The Night Walk is The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's annual fundraising walk and the nation's night to pay tribute and bring hope to people battling cancer. In 2010, the Walk raised more than \$45 million for research and patient services. The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's (LLS) mission is to cure leukemia, lymphoma and myeloma, and provide education and services for patients and their families.

Participants walk along a 1.5 mile route in their communities. Those who raise \$100 or more are called Champions for Cures, and carry lighted balloons - white for survivors, red for supporters and gold balloons in memory of loved ones lost. Light The Night is an inspiring evening with a carnival style atmosphere that is appropriate for all ages. Before the walk begins participants enjoy food, live music, and activities for the kids.

Last year, in approximately 230 communities, corporate and family & friends fundraising teams participated in a Light The Night Walk raising over \$360,000 for local blood cancer patients.
